provided "May Peace Prevail on Earth" themed floats during the 2024 King Kamehameha, Fourth of July, and Christmas parades here in Kailua-Kona. We successfully completed a District 5000 Grant funded "Peace through Art" project with a local school creating a beautiful 2024-2025 calendar for passing out to our Rotary friends, and local community partners. We planted several peace poles with the same message in numerous languages at Hale Halewai Park in Kailua Kona and along the Old Kona Airport walking path in the newly established "Peace Garden" to be dedicated on September 21st. We are nurturing "survivor" plant seeds from Hiroshima, Japan that will hopefully be planted with peace poles already placed around the west side of Hawaii Island.

We continued our monthly "Meet and Eat" food insecure feeding efforts at Kealakehe Intermediate School with over 60 families and 250 or more persons being supported.

We supported the Salvation Army with our yearly Christmas "Ding Dong Dinner" feeding efforts for ten needy families.

We are now a co-sponsor of the Kealakehe High School Interact Club with the Rotary Club of Kona. We assisted the Interact Club with an Ironman Water Station. We provided several Rotary connected scholarships to outstanding students at Kealakehe High School

We continued to support Rotary International Foundation Annual Fund giving and Polio Plus giving by members. We upgraded our club internet website, our club bylaws, and our club constitution. We had several Pau Hana fellowship events. We joined the Kohala-Kona Chamber of Commerce. We met with Gordon McInally, Rotary International President, when he visited the Big Island. Club members attended the Hawaii District 5000 conference in Kauai, and the Rotary International Convention in Singapore.

We welcomed three new members into our club this past year, Toni Symons, Cheryl Borsh and Shawn Keoho.

Finally, I dedicate my year as your President to Dennis Rast, who closely mentored me with Rotary and my role as President. Mahalo Nui Loa Dennis!
