



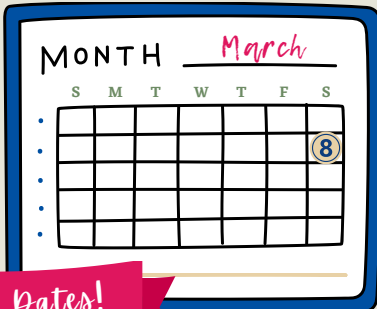
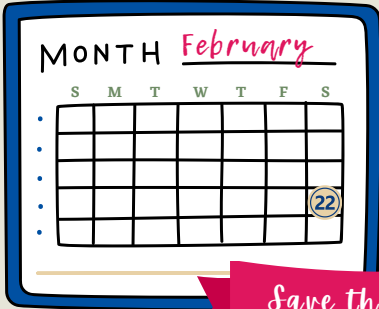

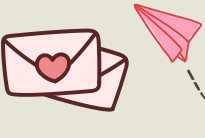

ALA MOANA HOTEL

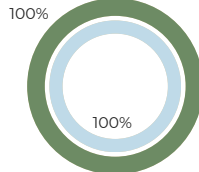

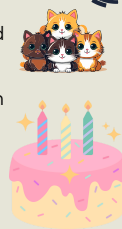
